PRAYER TO SAINT JOSEPH TO KNOW ONE'S VOCATION



Wouldn't it be great if you could attend a retreat for a few minutes a day in the comfort of your own home? The Parish Lenten Retreat is exactly that: a retreat that takes place mostly at your own home. Over the six weeks of Lent, participants will be paired up with a trained prayer companion. At a time that fits your busy schedule, you will meet once a week. What you two talk about is entirely up to you. The point of the conversations is to bring you into a conversation with God, to invite you to pray and reflect, be it on an important decision, or personal suffering, or relationships, etc.

Breaking Open the Word: Suggested text for faith sharing: Today's Gospel Reading: Matthew 6: 24 - 34.

Step One: Listen to the Word: Food, drink, clothing are mentioned in this passage. What anxieties do you feel when you release control of these things and put your trust in God?

Step Two: Look into your Life

Question for Children: What do you worry about? What can you do to stop worrying and rely on God? **Question for Youth:** Do you serve two masters? If so, what can you do to stop and serve only God? **Question for Adults:** Who really is the master of your life?
