## **Breaking Open the Word**

Suggested text for faith sharing: Today's Gospel:

John 3:14-21.

## Step One: Listen to the Word

As you hear Jesus words to Nicodemus today, which words or phrases strike you? What in this reading touches your heart?

Step Two: Look into Your Life

**Question for Children:** Who is one person in your life who supports your faith and helps it to grow?

**Question for Youth:** The Gospel speaks of following God as coming toward the light. How can you move towards the light in your own life? What is the darkness that needs Jesus' healing in your life?

**Question for Adults:** When is it difficult for you to believe? What particular line in this reading helps your faith?

# How is Jesus calling you this Lent?

We often get caught up in what we are doing during Lent: giving up sweets or our favorite television program, doing something for the poor we pass on the street... Have you ever stopped and asked: Jesus, what do you want from me? Perhaps He is calling you to visit Him in the sacrament of reconciliation? We tend to feel shame, and/or embarrassment when thinking about confession or even anger at the Church for imposing it on us. But, as Father Robert mentioned in his homily last weekend, we are meant to see this sacrament through the prism of the cross, a place where we encounter the peace, love, mercy and compassion of Christ. Our own image of God as a score keeper can become a stumbling block to partaking of the sacrament. This Lent, encounter the peace, love, mercy and compassion of Christ in the healing sacrament of reconciliation. Pray that any obstacles you may have be removed. Join us as we come together to celebrate this sacrament – some of us for the first time – on Wednesday March 21st - details below. Unsure as to whether you will have the courage to 'go for it'? Come anyways! Being open – even if you are not ready - to the possibility is pleasing to God as well!



**STATIONS OF THE CROSS**: Join the growing number of parishioners praying the Stations of the Cross, every Friday during Lent, at 8 am. Readers and Crucifix bearers needed! Signup sheet available on the communion rail. The devotion is followed by Mass at 8:30 am.

**MEDITATION GROUP** meets weekly on Tuesdays at 7 pm in the boardroom via 71 Roosevelt. What is meditation? After listening to a short reflection and a hymn, we are invited to repeat *Maranatha*, *Come Lord Jesus* in silent prayer for 20 to 25 minutes. You will be surprised at how quickly the time passes! Everyone is welcome, children too! Please bring free to bring a friend! No prior experience required, just a desire to sit with the Lord, together in silence!




