A NOTE FROM CONCERNED PARISHIONERS: We would like to thank all the parishioners who attended Mass with the Archbishop of Montreal, Christian Lépine and the meeting that was held afterwards to discuss the fall out of the Brian Boucher matter and sexual abuse in the church. We estimate that over 200 people attended Mass and over 100 stayed for the meeting with Bishop Lépine. The meeting, which lasted 2 hours, gave all present an opportunity to address the Bishop with statements and questions. The Bishop acknowledged the work of the Concerned Parishioners working group of Our Lady of the Annunciation, in particular, its letters to the Diocese and the president of the Canadian Council of Bishops, which highlighted the desire of all Catholics to see the problems of clericalism and sexual abuse addressed and policies and procedures put in place to prevent future events. 


EXPERIENCE HOPE, a modern
