LITURGY OF THE WORD

In today's reading from Jeremiah, the Lord declares a new covenant with his people. The Letter to the Hebrews presents Jesus as the perfect high priest. In today's Gospel, Jesus approaches his passion.

Theme: Jesus dies for us.

Breaking Open the Word

Suggested text for faith sharing: Today's Second Reading, from St. Paul, Philippians 2: 8-9.

Step One: Listen to the Word

As you hear this powerful hymn from the early church, what words or phrases strike you in it? Which line of this ancient hymn touches your heart?

Step Two: Look into Your Life

Question for Children: Name one thing that you will do each day this week to remind you that Jesus died and rose to new life for you.

Question for Youth: We hear the story of Jesus' death each year. What did you hear differently this year? How has your faith changed in the past year?

Question for Adults: Identify and share one way that you personally "die in Christ."

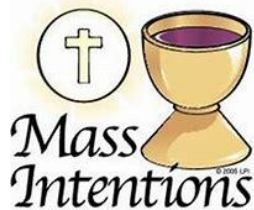
