<u>FOCUS</u>: Jesus, our path to salvation, calls us *brother and sister* and commands that we do the will of God. From the beginning, God has promised his people redemption. His love is stronger than sin and prevails over evil. Jesus comes to us to embody that love and set an example for us to follow. In doing God's will, he shows us the way to the Father and calls us to do the same on our journey to eternal life.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In Genesis, sin enters the world as Adam and Eve yield to the serpent's temptation. Paul's Letter to the Corinthians urges believers not to be discouraged: our earthly dwelling fades, but life in the Lord is eternal. Mark's Gospel shows Jesus being described by the scribes as "possessed." Jesus responds with a promise that doing the will of God makes us his brothers and sisters.

Theme: Following God's Will Breaking Open the Word

Suggested text for faith sharing: Today's First Reading from Genesis 3: 8-15

Step One: Listen to the Word

Which line in this reading caught your ear? What sense do you get about God as you listen to this Word proclaimed today?

Step Two: Look into Your Life

Question for Children: Why do our parents and teachers have rules we need to follow? Why do you think God has rules for us to follow?

Question for Youth: God has created us with free will, the freedom to follow or ignore God's will for us. How can you discover God's will for you?

Question for Adults: We humans are vulnerable to sin. Our sins most often lead to shame, mistrust, and blaming. How can following God's will free you from these destructive actions?



FUNDSCRIP: Fundscrip forms are due this weekend. Forms can be found on the communion rail and at the main doors of the church. Fundscrip is a passive means of fundraising. You purchase gift cards to your favorite stores; you receive the full amount you paid for and the parish gets 2% to 7% of your purchase – without any cost to you! Last month, parishioners made \$2,400 worth of purchases; the parish received \$70.50!




