ARE WE HYPOCRITES? Lori-Ann, one of our wardens, was in the office last Friday and got a sneak peek at our last bulletin. She laughed that right after the ‘awesome parish’ statement came the claim that we are humble. “Are we still humble if we say we are awesome?” she asked. Of course we are! Celebrating our awesome-ness does not take away from every other parish’s awesome-ness. Our faith is an AND faith, not an OR faith, meaning we can be both awesome and humble without being hypocrites. This AND practice teaches us to celebrate the blessedness of one another and drives away jealousy and envy. It promotes confidence and honesty without arrogance, allowing and even encouraging others to be genuinely awesome too.

ENSURING OUR AWESOME-NESS: As Christians each of us is called to be a welcoming presence, that is, to be receptive to the other. There are a lot of new faces in the pews. Help make them feel at home with a smile. When Mass ends, take a few minutes to reach out to a newcomer. Show them the bulletin, encourage them to be added to our email list... Remember Mass is a conversation. Just after the consecration, as we make final preparations to receive the Eucharist, Father Robert shares the peace of Christ with us and invites us to do the same with others. So after Mass, take a few minutes to welcome a stranger; one that is new to the parish, or one that you have been sitting alongside for several months. These small acts strengthen our ties as a parish family and help us take no one for granted.

REGISTRATION FOR CHILDREN’S FAITH EDUCATION (CFE) PROGRAM begins.

Parish children in Grade 1 this year through to Grade 6 should be enrolled in our weekly classes in order to receive the sacraments (**communion, confirmation, etc...**). Classes are held Tuesdays at 4:20 pm beginning October 1. Please contact the office as soon as possible to register your child. 5 WAYS TO KEEP YOUR CHILD INTERESTED IN MASS

1 Beginning late September, John Issa offers **Children’s Liturgy** on Sundays. Your child can join him for Father’s blessing after the opening rites. The children return to Mass during the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Running a little late? Your child can still join in. The classroom is located up the stairs at the parking lot entrance. We always need an adult to accompany John.

2 If your child is making you crazy, you can make use of the **playroom**, located to the left as you enter the main doors of the church.

4 Beginning late September, **Pflaum sheets** are available where the Mass books are kept.

3 Mass books are available on the back pew at the main entrance of the church so your child can follow along.


