Dear Parishioners,

On Friday, October 12th, we received a letter from attorneys involved in Fr. Brian Boucher's case informing us that the October 14th meeting with Bishop Faubert could potentially compromise the proceedings of the upcoming criminal trial. Consequently and out of caution and respect for the judicial process, it was thought prudent to request a **postponement of the meeting with Bishop Faubert** until a later date. We will advise of the new date for this meeting as soon as it is known. Bishop Faubert understood the situation and, despite this turn of events, wanted me to assure you that he wants to meet with us ASAP. The meeting **will** happen; we will confirm when shortly.

SO WHAT DO WE DO NOW? Whether you are affected by the charges against Father Brian, or concerned with the growing publicity facing the Catholic church at large, the worst thing we can do is fall into a state of 'why bother' or hopelessness, especially after having to postpone the meeting with Bishop Faubert. Regardless of your intention to come to the meeting, or your opinion and perspective on the issue at hand, we are called as Christ's followers to serve each other, first and foremost through prayer. Please keep our parish family in your daily prayers and consider adding an extra devotion/practice to your routine. We have several to choose from:




